
## Take These Steps to a Strong Math Culture

- Encourage perseverance and productive struggle





- Share information and resources for parents to use at home
- Connect math to all subject areas, such as writing in math journals or using formulas in science
- Keep math manipulatives and library books available for students to choose from in their free time
